I refer to your letter of 9 March 2017 requesting a meeting with a deputation from the Municipal District of Newcastle West and TII. The position in relation to your enquiry is as follows.

We endeavour to facilitate meeting requests with City and County Council delegations on an annual basis, which are representative of the Council and Executive, to discuss significant national road issues of interest to the Council.
